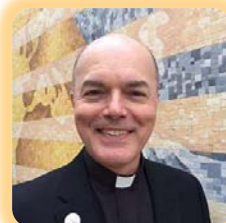


### English Keynote Address by Coach Bob Hurley

Bob Hurley coached basketball at St. Anthony High School in Jersey City, New Jersey from 1972 - 2017, building a local program into a national powerhouse in a community where hard times are a constant reminder of a world that is both uncertain and unsympathetic. Hurley, known as a coach with an uncompromising passion for basketball, has taken kids from the streets of New Jersey and elsewhere and transformed young boys into young men who just happen to play winning basketball.

### Spanish Keynote Address by Father Alejandro López-Cardinale

Father Alejandro López-Cardinale was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Caracas, Venezuela. He now works in the Archdiocese of Boston's Hispanic Ministry Office and serves as pastor. Fr. Alejandro is the President of La RED (National Catholic Network de Pastoral Juvenil Hispana). He holds a Masters Degree in Catechesis from Catholic University, Paris.
